CRISTALLO CARE GUIDE

Cristallo is a natural stone admired for its luminous beauty, elegant movement, and timeless appeal. Each slab has its own color, pattern, and texture. Because it can be fragile, especially around edges, corners, seams, and cutouts, extra care is essential.



DAILY CLEANING

Clean with warm water, mild dish soap, or a pH-neutral stone cleaner and a soft microfiber cloth. Dry with a clean towel. For deeper cleaning, use only pH-neutral stone cleaners.



WHAT TO AVOID

Avoid vinegar, lemon juice, bleach, ammonia, glass cleaners, bathroom cleaners, oven cleaners, strong degreasers, abrasive powders, steel wool, rough sponges, and acidic products.

Do not cut directly on cristallo or place hot items directly on the surface.



SPILLS & STAINS

Clean spills immediately, especially wine, coffee, citrus juice, tomato sauce, oil, vinegar, alcohol, makeup, perfume, and colored liquids.

Blot with a clean cloth. Prompt cleanup helps preserve the stone's natural beauty.



SEALING

Cristallo should be sealed after installation and resealed as needed.

To test the sealer, place water on the surface for 15 minutes.

If the stone darkens, it may be time to reseal.



BEST PRACTICES

Use coasters, trays, cutting boards, and trivets.

Protect edges, corners, seams, and sink cutouts.

Avoid strong impact, excessive pressure, or dragging heavy objects across the surface.

With proper care, cristallo can remain beautiful for many years.

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Cristallo is a natural quartzite admired for its luminous appearance, crystalline movement, and natural translucency. Each slab has unique variations in color, veining, and mineral composition.

For daily cleaning, use warm water, mild dish soap, or a pH-neutral stone cleaner with a soft microfiber cloth. Dry the surface after cleaning to help prevent mineral buildup and water spots.

Clean spills promptly, especially wine, coffee, oils, and other strongly pigmented liquids. Avoid abrasive powders, rough scouring pads, and harsh chemical cleaners that may affect the finish or protective treatment.

Cristallo may benefit from an impregnating sealer depending on the specific slab, application, and level of absorption. Sealing improves resistance to staining but does not make natural stone completely stain-proof.

Use cutting boards, trivets, and protective pads as good daily practice, and take extra care around edges, seams, and sink cutouts.

With gentle cleaning, quick spill removal, proper sealing, and daily protection, Cristallo can preserve its natural elegance and beauty for years to come.

DAILY CLEANING

Cristallo is not stain-resistant. Use warm water, mild dish soap, and a soft microfiber cloth. Wipe up spills immediately to help prevent water spots and cloudy residues. For deeper cleaning, use a pH-neutral stone cleaner.



WHAT TO AVOID

Avoid vinegar, lemon juice, bleach, ammonia, glass cleaners, bathroom cleaners, or abrasive scouring compounds. Avoidance products may dull or etch cristallo. Do not use density can be warm or place hot pans directly on the surface.



SEALING & PROTECTION

Cristallo should be sealed after installation and resealed as needed to help reduce absorption. However, sealing does not make cristallo stain-proof, heat-proof, scratch-proof, or acid-proof. Use coasters, trivet, cutting boards, and protective pads in high-traffic areas, and avoid with colored, harsh or strong impacts.



BEFORE YOU CLEAN

Before using any cleaning product, always try on a tiny invisible for approval on natural stone, sealant reduces the failure or products, could use reactive on sealer finish. When in doubt, follow the manufacturer's care instructions or contact a stone care specialist before applying any cleaners or treatments.
