SEMI PRECIOUS CARE GUIDE

Semi-precious stone surfaces combine natural gemstones with exceptional color, pattern, and translucency. Because composition can vary, gentle care helps preserve their brilliance and finish.



DAILY CLEANING

Clean with warm water, mild pH-neutral soap, and a soft microfiber cloth. Rinse and dry thoroughly to prevent residue or water spots.



WHAT TO AVOID

Avoid vinegar, lemon, bleach, ammonia, harsh solvents, oven cleaners, abrasive powders, steel wool, and rough sponges. Never cut directly on the surface or drag heavy objects across it.



SPILLS & STAINS

Wipe spills immediately, especially wine, coffee, oils, citrus, cosmetics, and colored liquids. Blot gently with a clean cloth and use only stone-safe, non-abrasive cleaners.



HEAT & LIGHT

Always use trivets or hot pads. Resin-bonded semi-precious slabs can be more heat-sensitive than the gemstone itself. Avoid prolonged intense heat and excessive direct sunlight, especially on vividly colored or translucent materials.



SEALING

Sealing needs vary by material and manufacturer. Some resin-bonded semi-precious surfaces may not require regular sealing, while others do. Always follow the supplier or fabricator's recommendations.



BEST PRACTICES

Use coasters, placemats, cutting boards, and protective pads. For backlit applications, keep lighting ventilated and accessible and avoid overheating or trapped moisture behind the panel.

With proper care, semi-precious stone can preserve its brilliance for many years.

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Semi precious stone surfaces are admired for their vivid colors, translucency, and natural gemstone composition. Each slab is unique, with variations in pattern, color, and structure that make it truly one of a kind.

For daily cleaning, use warm water, mild dish soap, or a pH-neutral stone cleaner and a soft microfiber cloth. Dry the surface thoroughly with a clean, soft towel to prevent residue and water spots.

Wipe up spills immediately to prevent staining. Because many semi-precious slabs contain resin and natural gemstones, protect them from excessive heat, harsh chemicals, abrasive products, prolonged direct sunlight, and impact on edges or corners.

Sealing needs vary by material and supplier. Always follow the manufacturer or fabricator recommendations. Use coasters, trivets, cutting boards, and protective pads to shield the surface from heat, scratches, and daily wear.

With mindful care and the right protection, your semi-precious stone surface will retain its brilliance and beauty for years to come.

DAILY CLEANING

Clean with warm water, mild dish soap, and a soft microfiber cloth. Dry with a clean towel to help prevent water spots and cloudy residue. For deeper cleaning, use only pH-neutral stone cleaners.



WHAT TO AVOID

Avoid vinegar, lemon juice, bleach, ammonia, glass cleaners, bathroom cleaners, oven cleaners, strong degreasers, abrasive powders, steel wool, rough sponges, and acidic products.

Do not cut directly on the stone or place hot items directly on the surface.



SEALING & PROTECTION

Semi-precious stone should be sealed after installation and resealed as needed to help reduce absorption. However, sealing does not make semi-precious stone stain-proof, heat-proof, scratch-proof, or acid-proof. Use coasters, trays, cutting boards, and trivets. Protect edges, corners, seams, and sink cutouts from strong impact.



BEFORE YOU CLEAN

Before using any cleaning product, always make sure it is safe for semi-precious stone. Avoid acidic and abrasive products, which can affect the surface finish.

When in doubt, follow the manufacturer's care instructions or contact a stone care specialist before applying any cleaner or treatment.
